ANNOUNCEMENT AND CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

Background

The Ministry of Health, Health Promotion Section is pleased to announce its 2nd Annual Health Promotion Conference to be held in Mwanza, Tanzania from September 12-16, 2022. This conference is primarily a response to growing expectations for new public health strategies in response to continuing public health threats including emerging and re-emerging infectious diseases. The first conference has seen increasing participation of community from across levels in various public health interventions. Nevertheless, lack of evidence of effectiveness of interventions remain. We welcome your engagement and your input in discussions about successes and challenges in achieving health for all through simple, cost effective interventions. As well as to discuss on how best to ensure that research models are applied to address health promotion services. The Conference objectives reflect the need for global health cooperation in preparedness and response to disease outbreaks, in public health emergencies, and in strengthening health systems!

The Second Annual Health Promotion Conference will provide an excellent opportunity to meet and participate in discussions with Government officials from Ministries, Regions and Councils, as well as other stakeholders from government and non-governmental organisations. It will also provide a platform to explore innovative health promotion approaches to prevent and control communicable and non-communicable diseases in Tanzania. Participants will also share ideas and experiences on community engagement in the provision of health services.


