2022 - 2023: THIS Overview

- THIS 2022-2023 was a householdbased national survey involving
 17,248 households
- 33,663 interviews were conducted between November 2022 and March 2023
- To measure progress towards the control of the HIV epidemic
- Second survey to measure national HIV incidence and viral load suppression



HIV prevalence, incidence & viral load suppression


2022-2023:HIV Prevalence

National HIV Prevalence among different age categories by sex




2022-23: HIV Prevalence by Region

Percentage of HIV prevalence among adults ages 15 and older – 2016-17







UNAIDS 95-95-95

• FIRST 95 (**Diagnosed**):

By 2025, 95% of all PLHIV will know their HIV status


• SECOND 95 (On Treatment):


By 2025, 95% of people with diagnosed HIV infection will receive sustained antiretroviral therapy (ART)

• THIRD 95 (Virally Suppressed):

By 2025, 95% of people receiving ART will have viral suppression
